Update: Dear Parishioners, in order to clarify the reason for the additional fund requests for the Capital Campaign for the school, you should know that the original scope of work included the renovations to the kitchen, locker rooms, and the need for a dedicated seating area for students in the cafeteria. This was done so that the gym wouldn't have to be used for lunch time seating. Air conditioning for the school and gym were part of the original scope of work. Based on current bids received, all of this work is within the original \$1.5 million that the campaign sought to raise. It was determined after the campaign was launched that necessary security improvements to the main entrance were crucial and cost approximately \$200,000 to secure that entrance. This is why we are asking the parishioners and school families of OLV to support the additional funds to reach the goal of \$1.6 million.

FROM THE PASTOR.....MY DEAR PARISH FAMILY, On August 16, 1987, Northwest Airlines flight 225 crashed just after taking off from the Detroit airport, killing 155 people. One survived: a four-year-old from Tempe, Arizona, named Cecelia. When rescuers found Cecelia they did not believe she had been on the plane. Investigators first assumed Cecelia had been a passenger in one of the cars on the highway onto which the airliner crashed. But when the passenger register for the flight was checked, there was Cecelia's name. Cecelia survived because, even as the plane was falling, Cecelia's mother, Paula Cichan, unbuckled her own seat belt, got down on her knees in front of her daughter, wrapped her arms and body around Cecelia, and then would not let her go. Nothing could separate that child from her parent's love—neither tragedy nor disaster, neither the fall nor the flames that followed, neither height nor depth, neither life nor death. This weekend we honor all those **MOTHERS** who gave us our life and supported us throughout our lives. May God bless all our Moms both living and deceased. They will all be remembered at the Masses this weekend.

I would like to take this space to **THANK** Jim Hoy and all those **VOLUNTEER RELIGIOUS EDUCATION TEACHERS AND AIDES** who gave of themselves this past school year. I know that many times it seems to be a thankless ministry. Probably this side of heaven, they will never see the fruit of their efforts. And for most of us, that is the way it is to be. All we can do is plant the seed of God's word and life into the hearts of His children and we need to let Him do the rest. Thank you all so much for a job well done and for now enjoy the free Sundays you will have during the summer. God bless.
